POLICIES

PRICING

Each clinic's price is determined based on the following factors: location, course curriculum, number of participants and any facility rental charges (if applicable). The base prices listed in this catalog are for clinics within a 60 mile radius to Grass Lake, MI. There is a \$1.00/per mile fee (round-trip) added to the base price for locations beyond the first 60 miles. There are a couple different options we can work with—

- Option #1—We charge per participant and cover our own expenses, as outlined above.
- Option #2—We charge a flat fee to the host, plus expenses, and the host works the pricing as needed. Our expenses include travel time, fuel, any fees incurred prior to or during travel (highway tolls/border crossing fees) & lodging. Though we prefer a hotel room, we would consider staying at the hosting location.

ADDITIONAL FEES

Stalls—It is the hosting location's decision to offer stalls, charge & collect the fee from the participants. It is suggested that you charge "X" amount if the stall is stripped before departure and "X++" if they are left "as is".

ADVERTISING

MMA will provide the flyer layout for distribution, along with posters and a suggested press release for the local and statewide papers to assist the host in generating as much publicity as possible. In addition, we will list the hosting facility on our website with their provided logo at NO ADDITIONAL CHARGE. This equates to FREE ADVERTISING FOR THE HOST FARM/FACILITY.

CANCELLATION

In the event that a clinic is cancelled or a participant is unable to attend due to extenuating circumstances, MMA will retain the tuition as a credit toward another clinic. If a participant is unable to attend, prior communications must be made or the tuition will be forfeited.

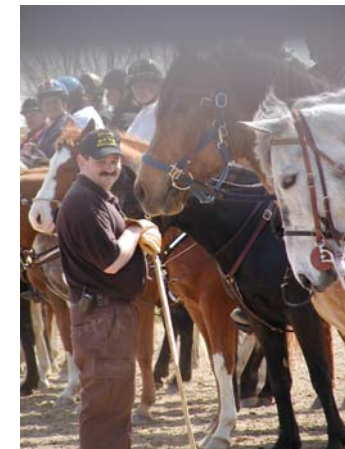


TRAIL SAFETY & DEFENSIVE RIDING

Before going through any of our Desensitization & Obstacle classes, also known as “BOMBPROOFING”, you should first stop and evaluate both you and your horse’s strengths and weaknesses, being completely honest with yourself. Then, CHALLENGE YOURSELF!

This course is offered at the beginner through the advanced levels, or any combination thereof. The sensory training will consist of both audio and visual stimuli. We will be working with smoke, flares, sirens and anything else that might cause panic—if even for a moment.
